Driver/Operators Best Practice

Purpose:

To maintain care and control of vehicle while wearing the required personal protective equipment during pump operations.

Practice:

- 1. All driver/operators should hold the proper Class license with air brake endorsement for the vehicle being driven. Drivers must be competent in the operation of vehicle. It is recommended drivers undertake a recognized driver training program.
- 2. All driver/operators must complete a 360 prior to moving apparatus.
- 3. All driver/operators should consider placing the vehicle in the fend-off position when arriving at roadway incidents to protect crews. Crews will exit the cab on the non—travelled side.
- 4. All driver/operators must wear approved safety footwear while driving or operating apparatus.
- 5. All driver/operators must wear approved safety helmet or hard hat during exterior pump operations. This includes when equipment is being repacked following an incident.
- 6. All driver/operators must wear DOT approved reflective jacket or vest which meet the requirements for day and night time visibility.
- 7. All driver/operators must wear hearing protection.
- 8. Rules of the road will apply under the Motor Vehicle Act soon to be Traffic Control Act.
